This course focuses on the study of international public law, generally understood as the set of rules binding the global conduct of states and non-state actors. Until the twentieth century, international law was largely the law of nations, but today it also includes the rights and duties of transnational organizations and individuals. Measured up to most domestic legal systems, the international legal system is primitive; there is a close connection between international law and international politics. The student of international law therefore will study a host of normative and legal uncertainties, wearisome perhaps, but this is what makes the course so interesting.

The main objective of this course is to develop the student's skills and knowledge on the foundations of international law, its evolution during the twentieth century, and its role in world affairs in the present day.

The thesis

A thesis on a particular topic of your choice (with a Supervisor's approval) will be completed by each student in the last semester. There is considerable scope in the choice of subject areas by the student and the research method employed. Each student is allocated a supervisor who guides them through the thesis. The thesis aims to assimilate the theoretical and practical elements of the academic program of study.

Duration of program: A Semester runs for a period of three months. Our "Master's Degree" programs are completed within the period of four semesters (one year). We allow extension in the period of study, in case your courses could not be completed within the stipulated time frame. No additional fee, no extra charge for extension in the period of study.
