**MS | ECONOMICS**

**T**his "Master of Science in Economics" is intended to equip students with the tools of the professional economist, for work in government, international organizations, business, or as preparation for economics research. Every year, approximately one-third of graduates go onto work in the private sector, one-third to the public sector and international organizations, and one-third to pursue further education. This Master's degree in Economics is based on thorough education in core areas of economics. Even though extensive use is made of mathematics, this is fundamentally to facilitate analysis.

It is expected that graduates of the program acquire a deep knowledge of modern economics. All courses have an applied focus to enable students study and gain tools that can be used in the real world. The courses prepare the students for the final summer course, where students apply all the material they have studied to complete a research Thesis/Project from the proposal stages to the final report.

**The thesis**

A thesis on a particular topic of your choice (with a Supervisor's approval) will be completed by each student in the last semester. There is considerable scope in the choice of subject areas by the student and the research method employed. Each student is allocated a supervisor who guides them through the thesis. The thesis aims to assimilate the theoretical and practical elements of the academic program of study.

**Duration of program:** A Semester runs for a period of three months. Our "Master's Degree" programs are completed within the period of four semesters (one year). We allow extension in the period of study, in case your courses could not be completed within the stipulated time frame. No additional fee, no extra charge for extension in the period of study.

**How to apply**

Prospective student must complete the Admission Form and pay the processing fee of \$45 USD or its equivalent. The processing fee is refundable if admission is denied.
